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Copper Tones

The trick to achieving this multihued copper eye is to follow your lids' natural contours when applying the shadow, says makeup artist Jeannia Robinette, who dreamed up the looks on these pages. For the green liner, follow the top lid only. Keep the rest of the face as simple as possible with tinted moisturizer and lip balm.

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Pool's Gold

The number-one rule of metallics? Skip the chunky prom sparkle. Instead, opt for sophisticated shimmers in skin-flattering shades. To keep the effect streamlined, Robinette suggests forgoing mascara altogether. Add a pop of contrasting color with cobalt lacquer on short, rounded nails.

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Quicksilver

For a polished look in a flash, focus on the mouth using just a slick of silvery, opalescent gloss. Robinette recommends dusting pink blush onto the apples of the cheeks for a healthy glow, then balancing the subtlety of the face with a fresh, fuchsia nail. Pack the gloss for post-beach touch-ups before a night out.

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Platinum Highlights

Metallic highlighter "mimics the sheen of dewy, healthy skin," says Robinette, who suggests patting on a transparent formula where the light hits the face (high on the cheekbones). On pale complexions, stick with shades of platinum or silver. For olive or dark skin, a warm bronze or copper hue is best. Silk mousseline dress with appliqués and embroidered rhinestone straps by Chanel. 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Golden Eyes

A wash of gold shadow on the lids has the same effect as a quick nap. "It brings light to the eyes, so they look open and rested," says Pechieux. At night, a few coats of black mascara make the shade anything but innocent. And if gold-plated eyelids seem too glitzy, "trace just a line of metallic shadow across the lashes or dab a transparent formula at the inner corners of the eyes for a brightening effect instead," Page says. 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FOXY BROWN

Brown is the color of dirt, but it can look remarkably clean. "Browns that contain gold or berry won't look flat against the skin," says Robinette. She dusts a shimmering bronzer over the cheekbones and forehead and along the hairline before patting sheer chocolate lipstick on the mouth with her finger. For evening, Pecheux suggests adding gold-flecked gloss: "It gives the mouth a youthful and sexy shine."

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BOLD BEIGE

To most women, beige means blah. Makeup artist Jeannia Robinette gives it spark by rubbing a sheer silver cream highlighter onto the eyelids and along the cheekbones and keeping the lipstick semimatte and beige. "Choose a shade that's a little warmer—not paler—than your natural skin tone," says makeup artist Fulvia Farolfi. And when in doubt, pink-beige lipstick is always flattering. *Linen top by Vera Wang. 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

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Embellished Enamel

High pigtails and plastic baubles are for little girls; a low ponytail looped neatly through an elastic decorated with enamel discs is all woman. 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Full Bloom

Some women fear that a big flower will turn them into the Black Dahlia—but the trick is to wear it back from the face. 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Double Band

Any updo (or down-do) can be embellished by a chain headband. Push one band back to the crown and the other near the hairline, making sure to tug up the hair between to reduce the priss factor. 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Blue Eyes

When brushed on sparingly, blue shadow enhances both dark and light eyes. Dump on a whole Pixi Stix's worth, and you'll end up resembling Veruca Salt. "I used a ton of eye shadow for this picture," Robinette says, "but the look doesn't translate well to real life—unless you're going clubbing." She recommends applying a vibrant blue pencil along the upper lashes and smudging it with your fingertips. "You can also mix light blue eye shadow with silver. Brush it over lids so there's just a little bit of color."

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Allover Pink

A strawberry flush can make anyone look Starburst-juicy. Sheer liquids and gel sticks blend easily into the skin, rather than sitting on top the way powder does. "Just smile, dot some on the apples of your cheeks, and smudge gently with fingertips for a natural glow," Robinette says. Lips get a swipe of pink or peach gloss that's as transparent and succulent as a Jolly Rancher.

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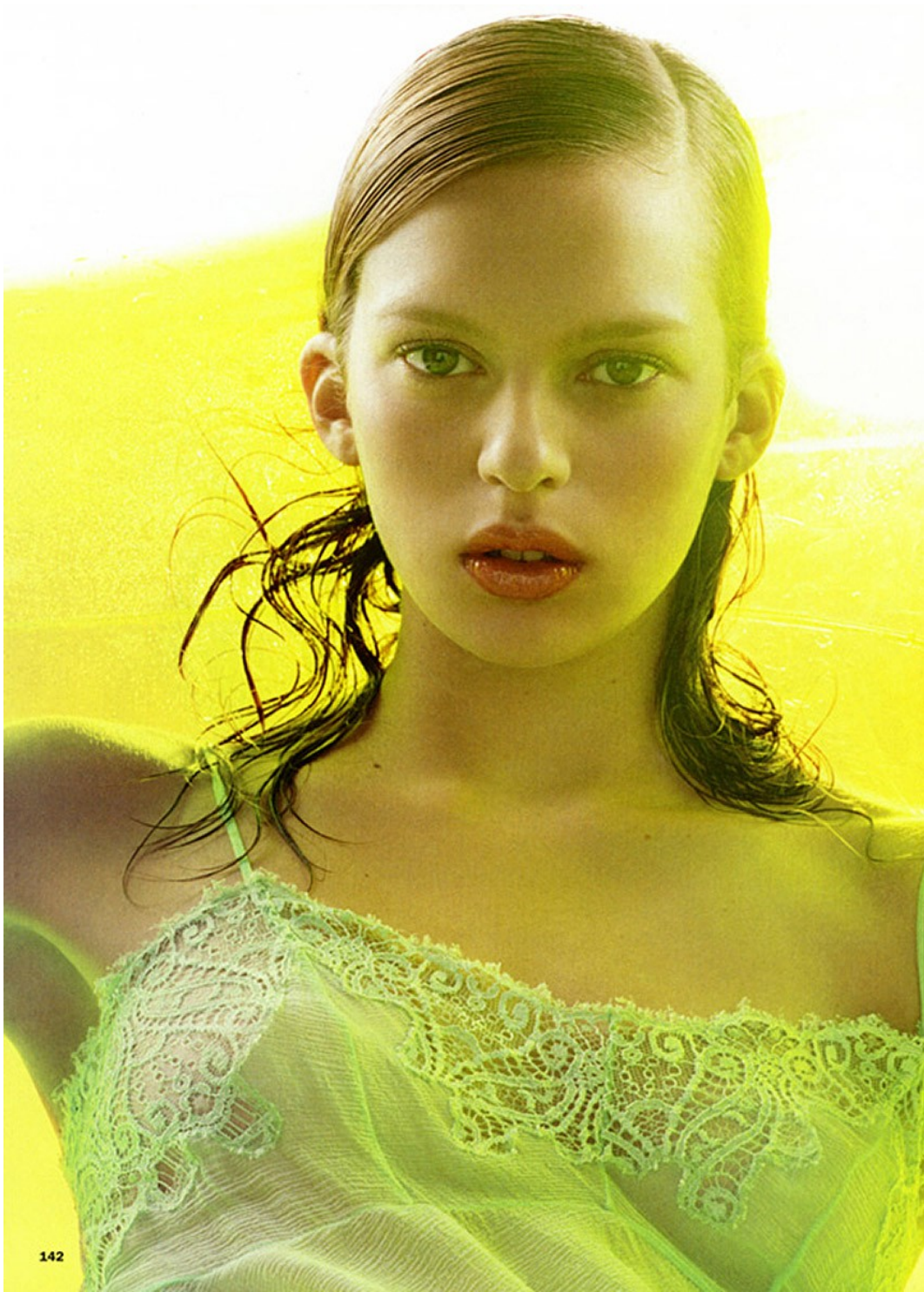
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

Into the Woods

Looking forward to fall's golden, crimson, and russet hues, stylist Thomas Hintermeier (who created the looks on these pages) thinks the best single-process shades mimic nature. For brunettes wanting more drama, he suggests adding a warm auburn tone: "When you go in the sunlight, you'll have a vibrant red shimmer."

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Smashing Pumpkin

The longer your hair, the more weathered the ends are. By adding pigment (instead of bleaching it out), a single process smooths damaged cuticles so hair seems shinier and healthier. But steer clear of burgundy, says Hintermeier. "Bluish-red hair doesn't exist in nature—try gold undertones instead."

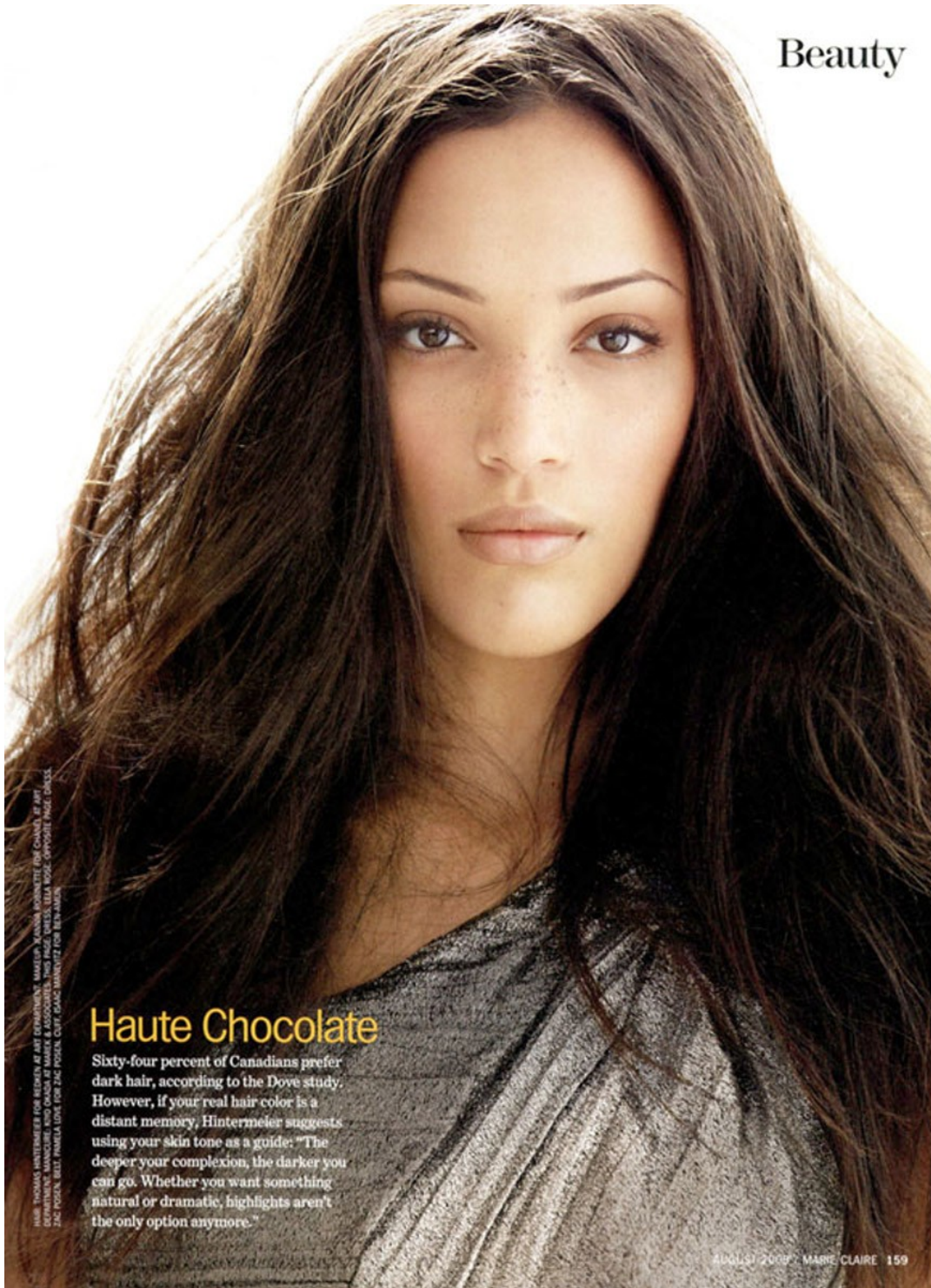

Sixty-four percent of Canadians prefer dark hair, according to the Dove study. However, if your real hair color is a distant memory, Hintermeier suggests using your skin tone as a guide: "The deeper your complexion, the darker you can go. Whether you want something natural or dramatic, highlights aren't the only option anymore."

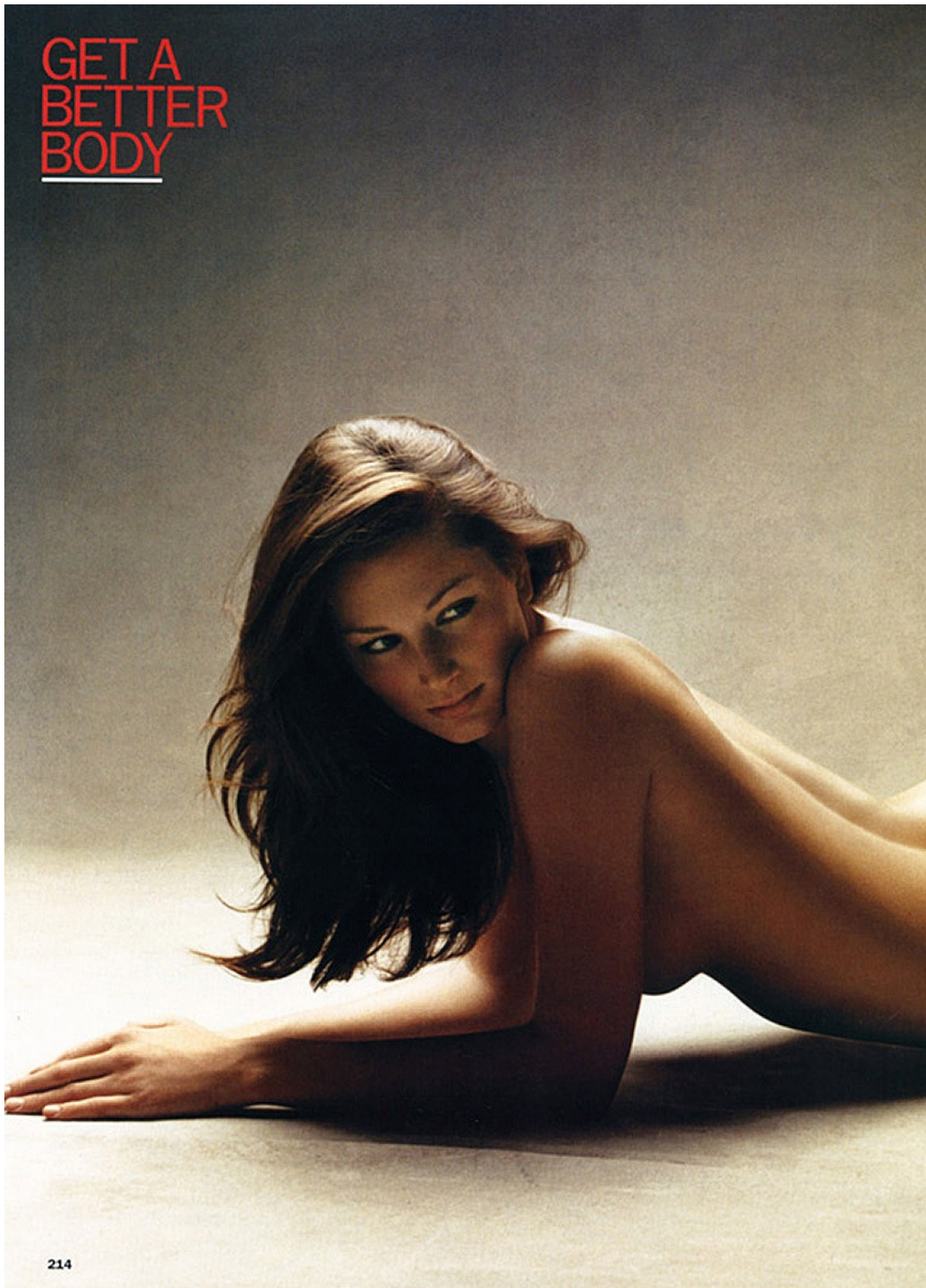

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Decent Exposure

Spring weather lifts the spirits but challenges the skin. Suddenly, you realize your body isn't quite ready for all that bareness. But there are simple ways to fight bumps, flakes, blotches, and dullness. By Laurel Naversen Geraghty

May, not April, could actually be the cruelest month: The first glimpse of ashen skin, blue veins, callused feet, and unexpected hairs can make you feel as though the body is thoroughly unprepared. "May is really the month of self-discovery," says Ranella Hirsch, a dermatologist at Boston University Medical Center. What's more, the change of season can prompt a whole new set of issues. "It may be instantly

hot and humid, so on top of all your dry skin, you're suddenly having oiliness and acne, or even an allergy that starts in the spring with the first burst of sun exposure," says Audrey Kunin, associate clinical instructor of dermatology at the University of Kansas School of Medicine. Fortunately, skin responds well to kindness. The right treatments are new sources of hope—something that spring manages to inspire even in the wasteland.



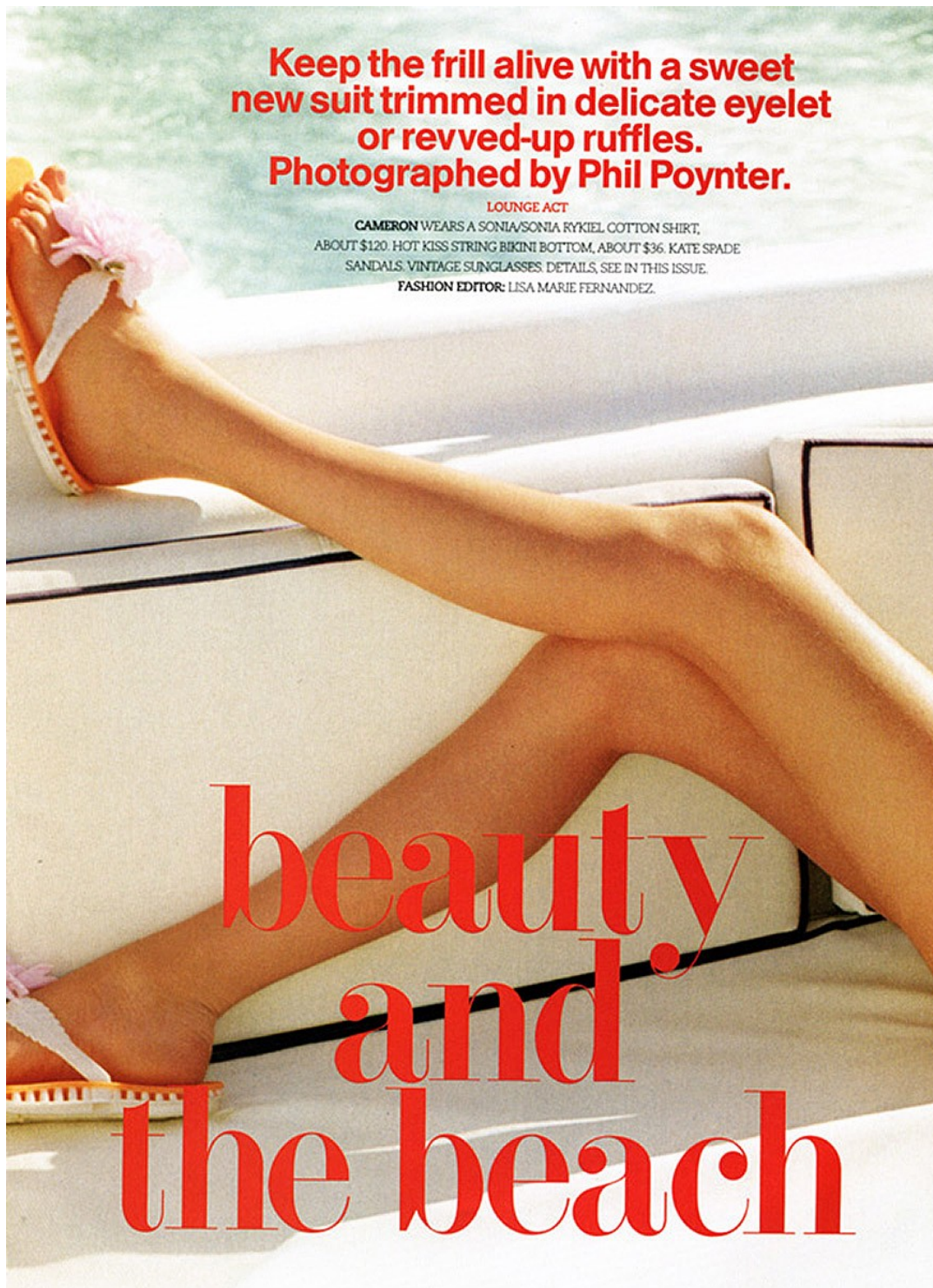


