Three years ago, when the Australian actress Margot Robbie was leaving her role as Donna on the country's hit TV series *Neighbours*, she had one parting wish. "I wanted to be killed off—a big, violent death. And they said no, so my character ended up going to school in New York," she says. "They wanted to give me an option to come back."

Robbie didn't need it. She hatched her own plan to move to New York, where she nabbed a lead on the short-lived ABC show *Pan Am*. Soon after, she landed what many sectors consider to be the holy grail: a part in a Martin Scorsese film. In *The Wolf of Wall Street*, out now, Robbie plays Leonardo DiCaprio's mistress-turned-second wife. "It was a sink-or-swim situation," she says of working with the two heavyweights. "I had to rise to the challenge." One such challenge was a masturbation scene that took 17 hours to shoot. "Your legs go stiff after that long," she observes.

Fortunately, Robbie, 23, is no willing lily. Growing up on a farm, she chopped firewood and spent her free time surfing, jet skiing, and playing beach cricket. She's also wise enough to know that it takes more than talent to make it in Hollywood. "You have to play the game; you have to be business-savvy," says the actress, whose next role is opposite Will Smith in the film *Fences*. "People ask me, 'How do you remember your lines?' That's nothing. That is the least of my concerns." VANESSA LAWRENCE

Tinted Love

In an endless variety of shapes, sizes, and colors, there's a pair of shades for everyone.

I love that in the forties you only saw women in glamour mode," says actress Juno Temple, who, in *Miu Miu*'s cobalt-tinted cat-eye sunglasses, recalls the sultry allure of a young Katharine Hepburn. The film noir frames are just one example of spring's character-laden silhouettes, from Stella McCartney's cartoonish round shades to Proenza Schouler's Batman-style renditions. "Different shapes completely change your look," says the British-born, Los Feliz-based actress, who counts seventeen pairs of sunglasses in her collection, including Warblers, aviators, and John Lennon specs, with green, pink, and metallic lenses so she can "see the world in different colors."

Embracing alternative viewpoints is, after all, paramount to the performer's success. Since her breakthrough appearances in *Notes on a Scandal* and *Atonement*, Temple, now 22, has worked almost nonstop and awaits four film releases this year, including *Jack and Diane* (out in June), as Riley Keough's girlfriend, and *The Dark Knight Rises*, the final installment in the Batman trilogy (July), in which she is cast alongside Christian Bale, but on that subject her lips are sealed. "I've played some extraordinary characters—I love a challenge"—is all the daughter of film director Julien Temple and producer Amanda Temple will hint at. (The multitalent also plans to learn guitar and put out a large collection "that makes all shapes and sizes feel good.") Meanwhile, at a petite five-foot-one, Temple wears *Miu Miu*'s ladylike frocks to maximum red-carpet effect. "You don't have to be a ten-foot beanpole to look good," she says. "And that's empowering." —ESTHER ADAMS

HEAR THEM HOWL

If it hadn't been for some parental matchmaking, **the Dove and the Wolf**, aka Paloma Gil and Louise Hayat-Camard, might never have met. Gil grew up in Paris; Hayat-Camard in Martinique. But Gil's mother introduced them when they were 14 and, Gil says, "We started playing music together." Now 22, the duo, whose band name is a multilingual play on words — "paloma" is Spanish for "dove" and "loup" (which sounds like Lou, Hayat-Camard's nickname) is French for "wolf" — just released their first EP, a four-song collection of spare but soaring harmonies. They came to T's attention via Gaby Basora, the fashion designer for Tucker, who hired Hayat-Camard to babysit her sons while in Paris for business. Cut to a recent day in the Rockaways, a surf spot in Queens where the musicians were making a video for Tucker's resort collection, set to their song "Springtime." "It's one of the first songs we wrote together," Hayat-Camard says. "It's about growing up and leaving the place you've always lived in." **NANCY MACDONELL**

TRUE SPARK

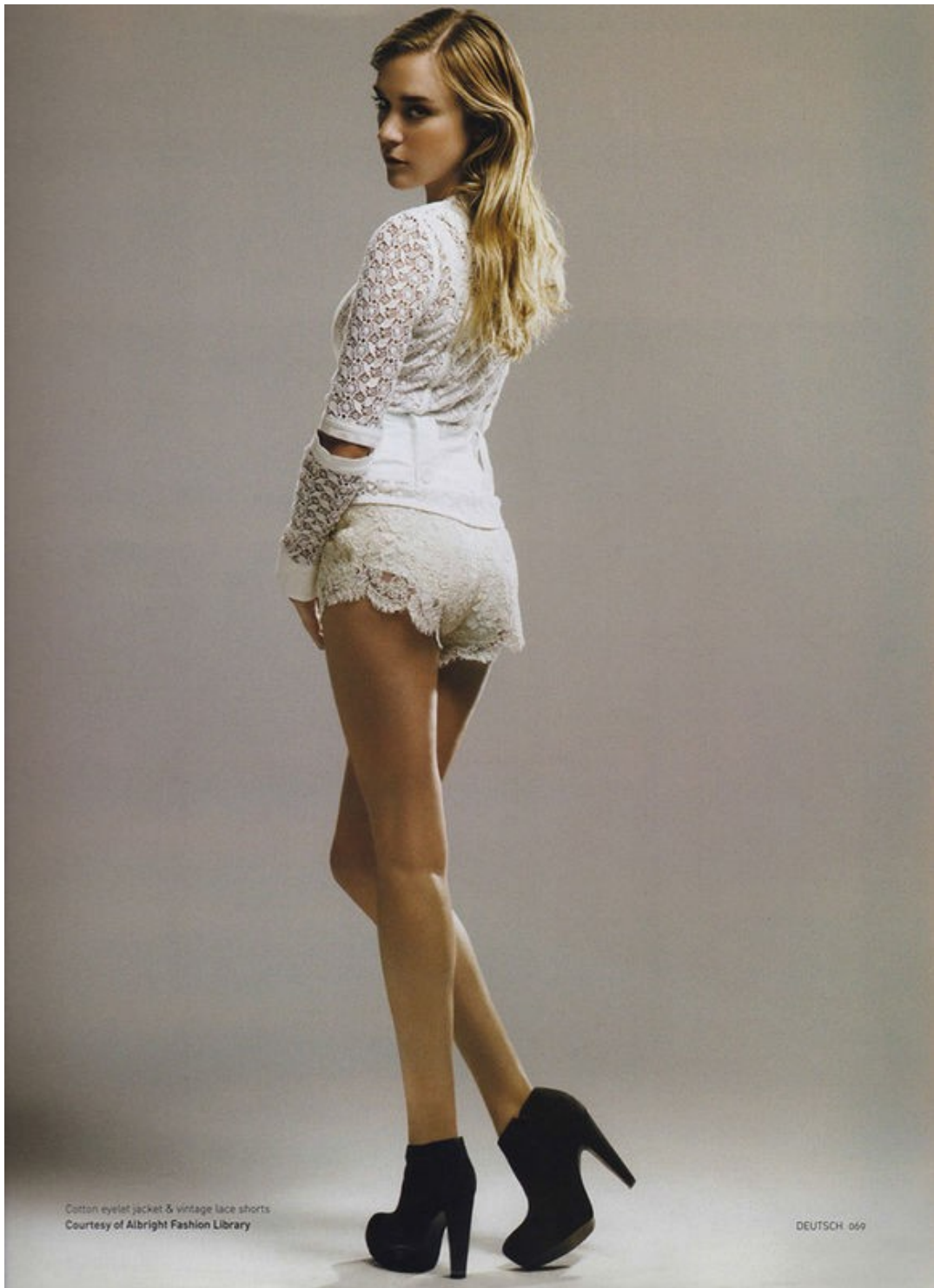
Kids sometimes see a movie that stirs something inside them, but they don't often talk about it. That's why I love True Spark. This organization provides films that promote positive character traits to students all across the country—inspiring stories and stand-up characters that young people can get behind, like *Rudy* or *October Sky*. Then it gets the kids to discuss how those qualities might translate into their own lives. My movies *Bridge to Terabithia* and *Because of Winn-Dixie* have been shown, and I've even videotaped special introductions. When I visit a group after a screening, I answer their questions, and we'll talk about how the things they've watched have influenced them. It's a cool platform for kids to think about what place empathy and humility have in their own lives.

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THE POWERHOUSE •

P J HARVEY

Singer, songwriter, guitarist.

Six albums.

P.J. Harvey is the Emily Brontë of rock 'n' roll: her work is foreboding, intricately designed, and, at times, just a little out of control. Like the author of *Wuthering Heights*, Polly Jean grew up in the English countryside—in a hamlet just outside of Yeovil—and spent her childhood in what she has described as a “hippie household.” She was familiar with the music of Captain Beefheart and John Lee Hooker at an early age, and so, for her, coming up with a rough, distinctive sound rooted in the blues was second nature. There are no wasted notes or excessive rock 'n' roll gestures on her two finest albums, *To Bring You My Love* and *Is This Desire?* The music on those records is strict, perfectly crafted, and pared down—but still beautiful and charged with emotion. Last year she spent six months living and writing in New York. On her new album, *Stories from the City, Stories from the Sea*, you can hear what it sounds like when a furiously intelligent, iconoclastic country lass puts herself to the test in the city of gridlock and glamour.
