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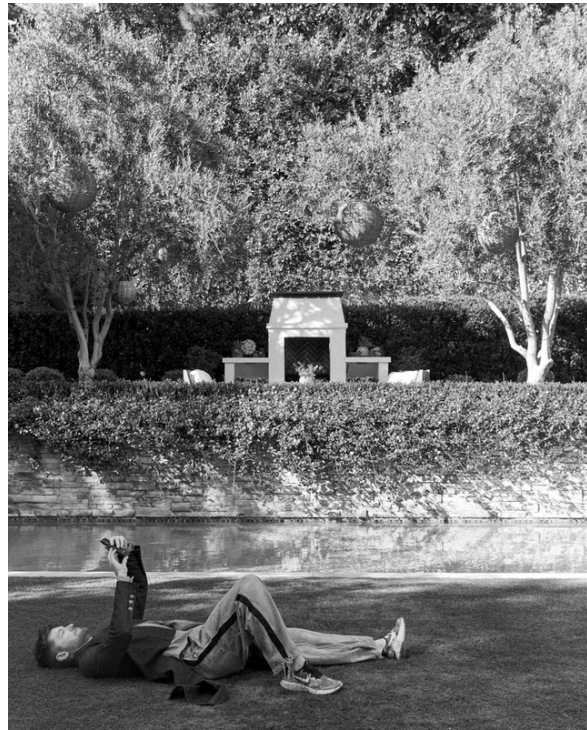

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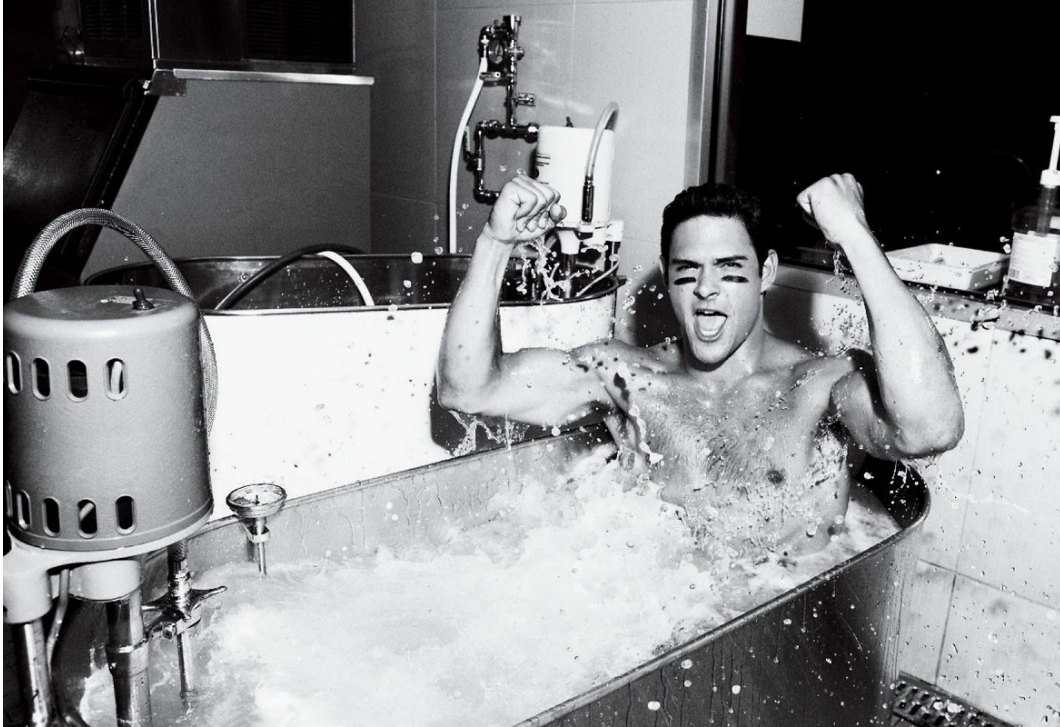

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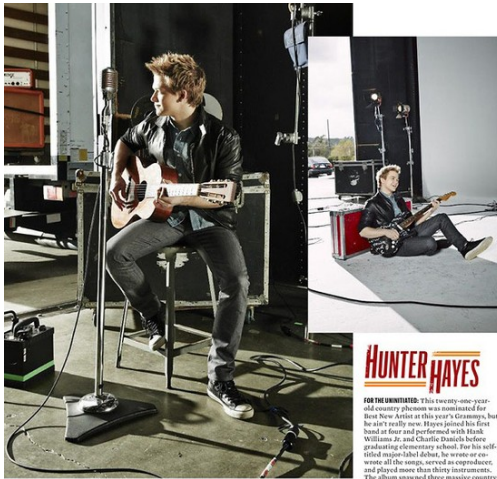
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## HUNTER HAYES

**FOR THE UNINITIATED:** His twenty-one-year-old country phenom was nominated for Best New Artist at this year's Grammys, but he's not really new. Hayes joined his first band at four and performed with Blake Williams Jr. and Charlie Daniels before graduating elementary school. For his self-titled major-label debut, he wrote or cowrote all the songs, served as coproducer, and played more than thirty instruments. The album opened at one million country radio hits, and he's logged more than two hundred dates a year in the road.

**ON GROWING UP COUNTRY:** "Every demo I do has a little bit of cowboy on it because of the amount of the Mustangs or classic country world that I grew up listening to and that first drew me in. And then I always try to find someone for a blues guitar sound, because that's also what I love. Musically, the blues opened [my] massive country radio hits, and he's logged more than two hundred dates a year in the road."

**TELL US MORE ABOUT THAT:** "Country music hasn't always been perfect and audience. There's a conviction because there's a vulnerability, a confidence, a quality, so you can't be overacting. Those lyrics take you in."

**WHAT HE'S LISTENING TO:** Memphis "Big Long Hair," Loni McKenna, "Ladies and Gentlemen."

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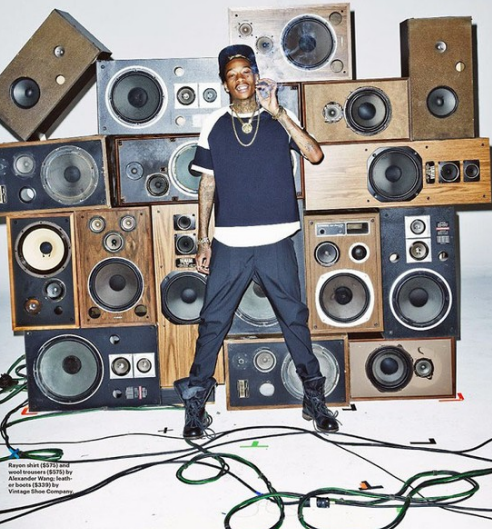
## WIZ KHALIFA

**FOR THE UNINITIATED:** Typically photographed with a giant fish of smoke hovering overhead, Wiz Khalifa earned his reputation on the back of good old-fashioned hustle. Mixtapes and hard-working talent in his budding previous track, "Black and Yellow." Last year, he released *O.F.T.B.*, which has already generated two hit singles, "Work Hard, Play Hard" and "Remember You."

**ON HIS SOUND:** "In those parties, in my songs are really just about smoking weed and having fun. When somebody isn't having a great day, I like to be the guy that takes that bad off your back."

**ON GETTING INTO IT:** "This is a serious job. It's why I'm constantly at odds with friends and family—they don't understand why I go to work, why I never come home. I like learning new things. Right now, I'm learning to use people and get my money. After talking to people who work for Donald Trump—count, successful people—I've realized I gotta go after all that. That's what I'm going to do that I didn't do last year."

**FOR THE UNINITIATED:** He calls them his "Four Kings"—Michael Jackson, Prince, Steve Wonder, Sammy Davis Jr.—and in his song lyrics, Grammy-winning solo artist, dancer, and actor, the influence is not just in the lyrics, but in the way he performs. He has the highest number of hits in the genre. "I'm not an artist, I had to teach myself—of the single—everything I do. I just kept doing it and doing it until the amazing Michael Jackson."

**ON SAMMY DAVIS JR.:** "I grew up in Las Vegas. My mom worked in pretty much every casino on the Strip. She brought home the Rat Pack stuff. Sammy was the only one that looked like me, so I naturally gravitated to him. Sammy made it cool to be black at a time when, you're just one of the crowd, very cool to be black. His name was on the front of the building in lights, and he had to go in the back that you never see him there."

**ON THE BIG MOMENT:** "Early on, I was at a festival in Japan—eighty thousand people. My first song was 'No Black,' which was my first number one as an artist, and I turned the mic around to the crowd and they sang the whole song. Every lyric. That was my first experience with the power of music. No barriers exist. Age, Race, Language. A great song that transcends everything else."
