the art of style

Designer Donna Karan is a woman who has mastered the art of getting dressed in the morning. At 66, she's attired simply in a black shirt and black skinny pants, with wide leather cuffs at her wrists and a giant black necklace made from twists of leather. She looks youthful without being inappropriate, stylish without being staid. "I have a system of what I like and what I don't like," she shrugs, "and it really doesn't change much from season to season."

The same philosophy of simplicity and ease has been at the heart of her design ethos since Karan first started out as a designer in the late 1960s. Born in Queens, New York, to a mother who was a model and a father who was a custom tailor, she has worked in fashion since the late 1960s when she took her first job with legendary American designer Anne Klein. After taking over the company when Klein passed away in 1974, Karan eventually founded her own label, which this year celebrates its 30th anniversary.

"My goal has always been to make a difference in women's lives," the designer explains, sitting in the New York West Village loft that was the art studio of her late husband, Stephen Weiss. "I want to simplify everything, because when you don't have to think about what you're wearing, you can get on with what really matters."

Karan — who is still very much at the helm of her eponymous brand, as well as her DKNY diffusion line, and the Urban Zen Foundation (an organization that combines her love of design with her philanthropic work) — has spent her career reinventing her "seven easy pieces", a capsule wardrobe comprised of the key items that every woman needs to take her from the school run to the office, from day to night, that remain favorites from season to season. Here Karan explains her rules of heroine dressing. >

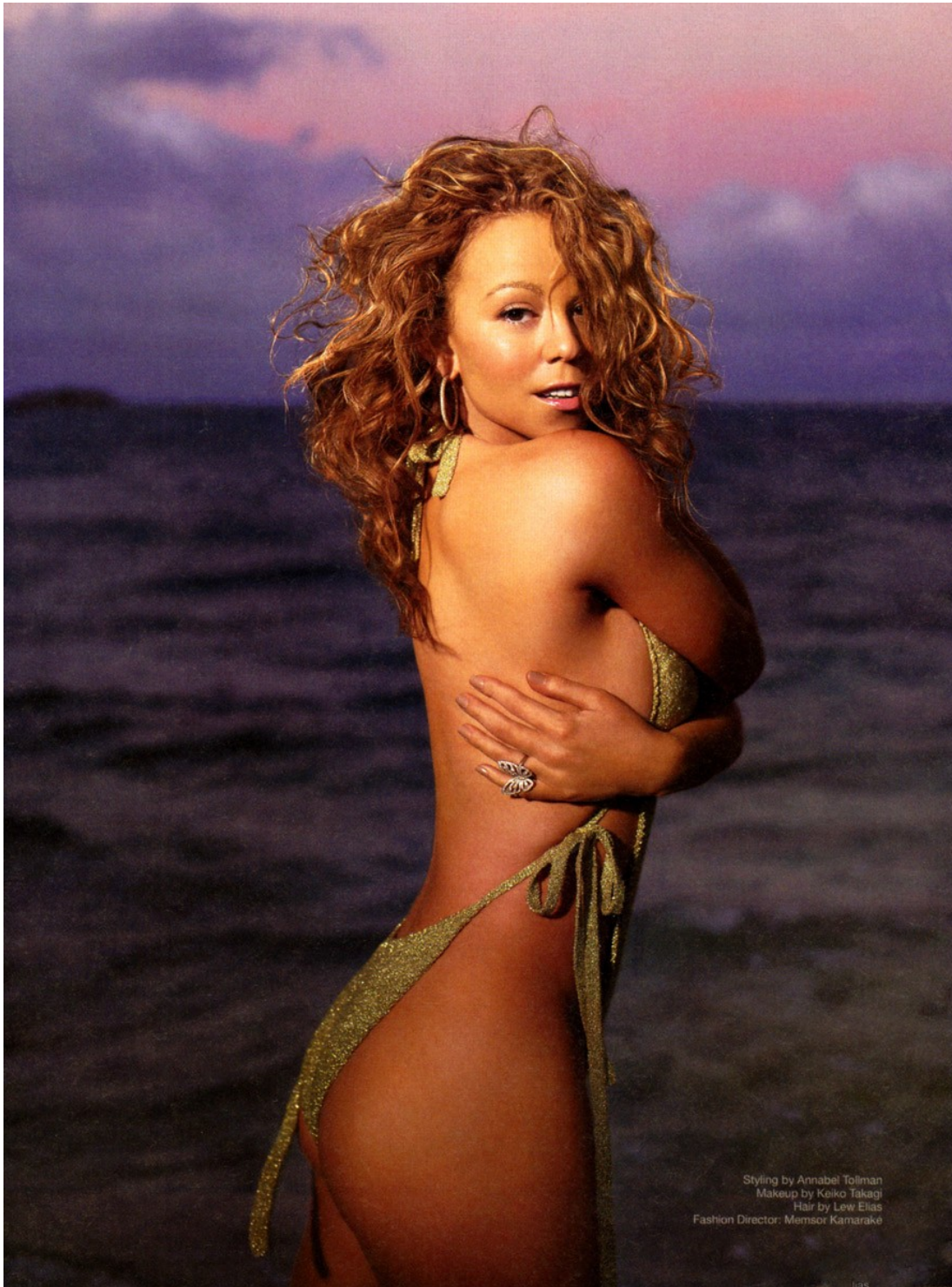

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jordin SPARKLES

As she prepares to light up the big screen, pop star Jordin Sparks reveals her sexy new silhouette and shares the details of her 50-pound weight loss.

IT'S A GORGEOUS SPRING DAY IN NEW YORK CITY, and Jordin Sparks is on her way to lunch at a downtown restaurant. She's approaching the front door when a group of tourists recognizes her. Quickly they gather around the singer, asking her for autographs and to pose for photos—which the vivacious 22-year-old happily agrees to do. It's been five years since Jordin wowed the country with her powerful voice and became one of the youngest contestants to take the *American Idol* title, but she's just as recognizable today. She's released two hugely popular albums—the first went platinum—and earned a Grammy nomination for her single "No Air." 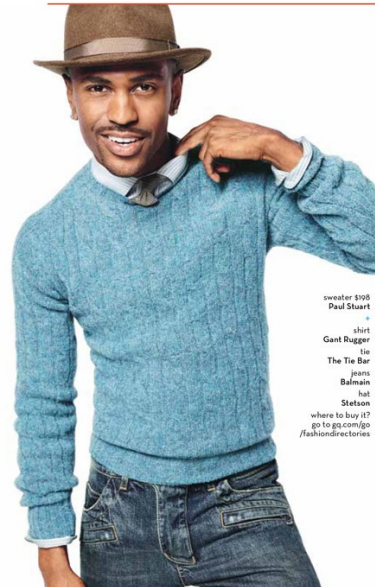

Tremble Before Norman the Zombie Slayer

When Norman Reedus first wandered onto *The Walking Dead* halfway into the first season, it didn't seem like he was going to last long. His character, Daryl Dixon, was angry, greasy, a loner on a show whose ethic is that unity is the only way to survive. But Reedus, 44, played Daryl's nasty lines like they were born of existential torture—more abused than abuser. "I wanted to play it like I was sort of embarrassed of who I was," he says. And as the fourth season begins, Daryl has evolved from a racist hillbilly to the show's unlikely moral center.

Reedus, meanwhile, has gone from tenuous guest star to the mega-hit's most beloved regular. His online fans (they have names like Norman's Nymphos and Reedusluts) gave him a huge reception at Comic-Con this year—amazing, considering Daryl's mere presence used to annoy fans of the comic because his character wasn't in it. "Call them nerds, whatever, man," he says. "I fucking love nerds." —TAFY BRODESSER-AKNER

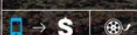

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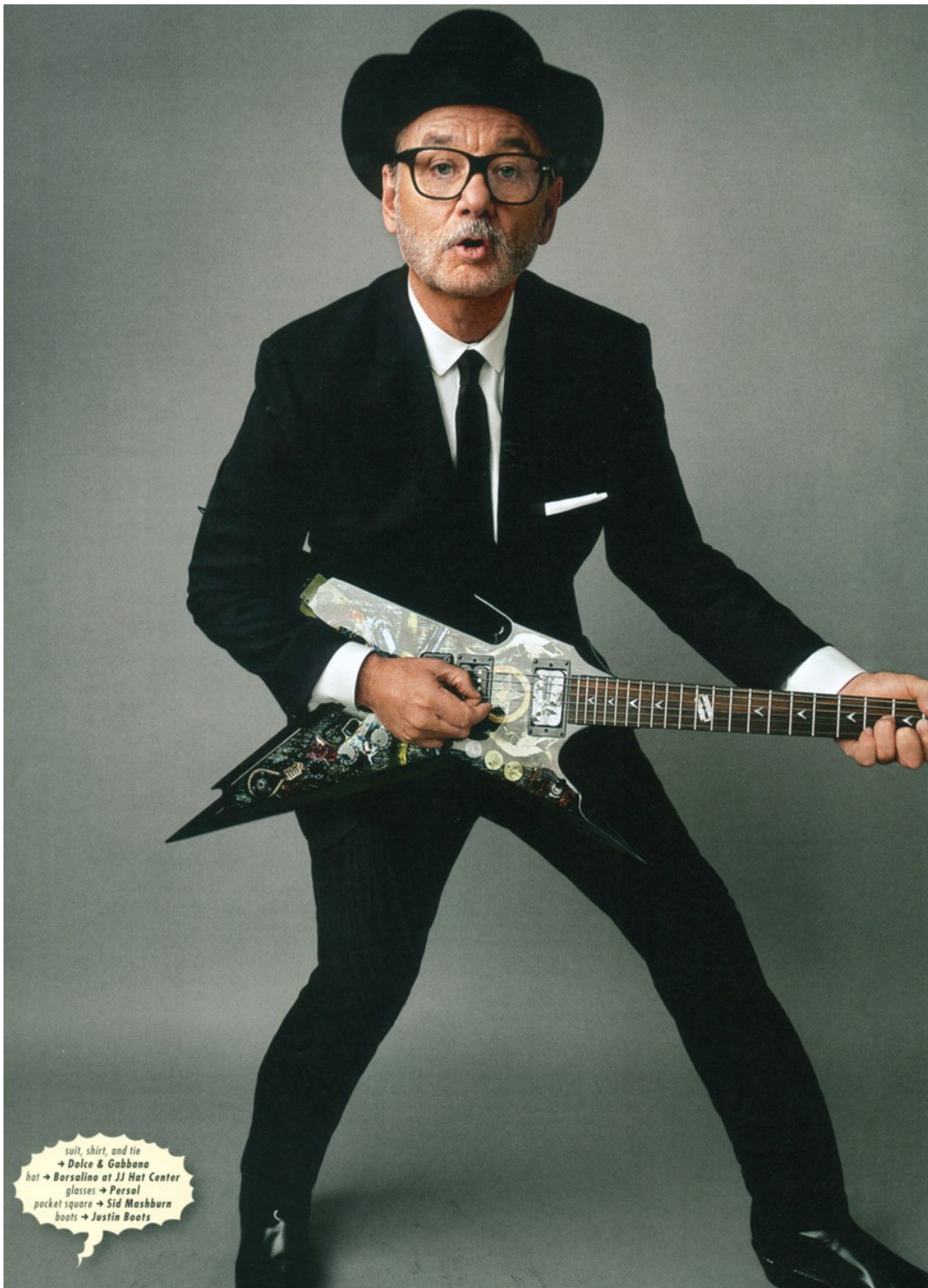
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
