The Summer Ankle Boot
On the one foot, you've got the chukka, a washed, lightweight, and slightly dressy ankle boot named for its resemblance to the footwear worn by old-time polo players. On the other, you've got the subtle, crew-heeled desert boot, which has its origins in the heavily structured, crepe-soled, ankle-high boots worn by the British army in North Africa in World War II. Between the two, you've got two quintessential summer boots that offer the minimum of uncomfortable structure. They typically come in brown suede, and the season's best iterations—like these from Kenneth Cole and Shipley & Hutton—emphasize other areas of the spectrum.
